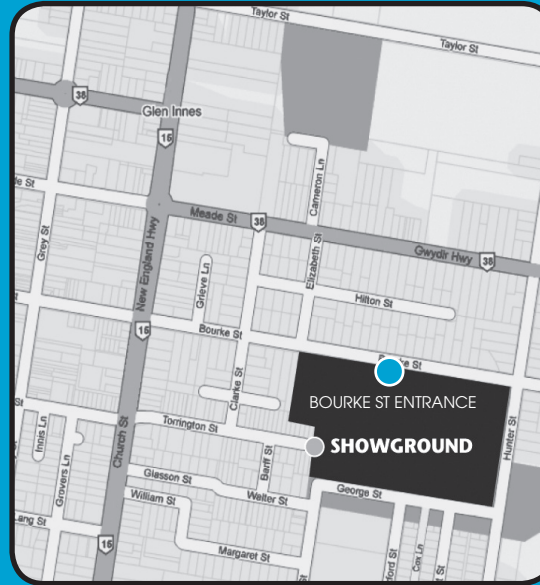

John Anderson



John Anderson is a sixth-generation farmer and grazier from New South Wales, who spent 19 years from 1989 in the Australian Parliament. He served as a senior Cabinet minister in the reformist government led by John Howard (1996 to 2005), one of the most successful governments in Australian parliamentary history. This included six years as Leader of the National Party and Deputy Prime Minister.

Whilst in office, Anderson, known as a man of simple Christian faith, sought to respect the dictum that another's right to speak should always be defended, even if he disagreed with them.
